**Postage Increase Coming**

The United States Postal Service has announced an increase in postal costs. Beginning May 12, 2008, a first-class mail stamp will cost 42 cents. Customers who have purchased the forever stamps at 41 cents can continue to use them, even after the price change. You can stock up on these forever stamps now before the price change. The

Post Office has promised to have 5 billion forever stamps in stock to meet this increased demand before the price change occurs.

Postage for a postcard will be 27 cents, which is a 1-cent increase. And other shipping services will have price increases that will be announced in March.

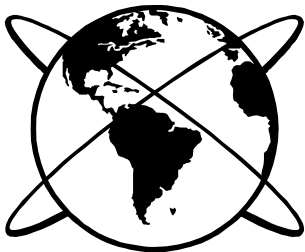
